## 24 HOUR EMERGENCY ADVICE

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Vehicle accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
Spill or leak	Prevent migration into the environment - onto adjacent land or into waterways. Absorb with appropriate inert material and sweep or scrape up. Wear protective equipment including eye protection to avoid exposure. Large spills due to traffic accidents, etc., should be reported immediately to CHEMCALL and NZTA for assistance.
Fire	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> May emit toxic fumes when exposed to heat.

## FIRST AID

<b>If swallowed</b>	If product is swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Contact a Poisons Information Centre / doctor immediately. Rinse mouth with water if possible.
<b>If in eyes</b>	If splashed in eyes, hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists: Get medical attention.
<b>If on skin</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs thoroughly wash affected areas with soap and water. If irritation occurs, get medical advice.
<b>If inhaled</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. Get medical attention if breathing difficulty develops.

## STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

**Storage:** Store **securely** in a cool dry place. Protect from heat. Keep secured, well out of reach of children and animals.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
