PLEASE READ LABEL COMPLETELY BEFORE USE

Cyrosshield Liquid contains 500g/L cyromazine in the form of a water soluble concentrate. Cyrosshield Liquid is a non-stripping dip that will give residual protection of sheep against flystrike caused by all the common strike flies including the Australian blowfly (*Lucilia cuprina*) for up to 12 weeks. The period of protection may be reduced by incorrect application; excessive fleece soiling; heavy fleece conditioning; if infection such as mycotic dermatitis (fleece rot) are present; or if prolonged heavy rain occurs following application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice when necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

USE RATE

FOR LONGER TERM PROTECTION (up to 12 weeks)

Mix 2 litres of Cyrosshield liquid with 1000 litres of water and apply by showering, plunge dipping or jetting. Top up at the same rate. Because this is a non-stripping dip, no reinforcement is required.

FOR MEDIUM TERM PROTECTION (up to 6 weeks)

Mix 1 litre of Cyrosshield liquid with 1000 litres of water and apply by showering, plunge dipping or jetting. **DO NOT use this rate for hand jetting or through spray races.** Top up at the same rate. Because this is a non-stripping dip, no reinforcement is required.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS:

It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the New Zealand (Maximum Residue Limits of Agricultural Compounds) Food Standards.

MEAT: Sheep producing meat or offal for human consumption must not be sold for slaughter either during treatment or within 7 days of the last treatment.

MILK: Milk intended for sale for human consumption must be discarded during treatment and for not less than 35 days following the last treatment.

WOOL RESIDUES:

Ensure the timing between dipping and subsequent shearing is at least two months, except in case of spot treatment for flystrike. For advice on your dipping programme, contact your supplier.

If skin or hair contact occurs remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. **EMERGENCY RESPONSE:** In case of spillage, wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering water ways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely. **DISPOSAL:** Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill or other approved facility. Triple rinse container and add rinsate to dip wash. Burn in an appropriate incinerator, if circumstances such as wind direction permit, otherwise crush or puncture and bury in a suitable landfill.

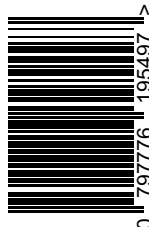
